NEW THIN LIZZY RELEASE AS GOOD AS LIVE AND DANGEROUS

This week, Thin Lizzy released a live album called Still Dangerous. The set is from a 1977 gig the band played in Philadelphia. Of course, this isn't Thin Lizzy's first live album – their 1978 effort Live and Dangerous is among their fans' favorite records. However, guitarist Scott Gorham says Still Dangerous rivals even that iconic album.

(Actuality #2) “You know, people talk about the Live and Dangerous album, and I kind of get myself in trouble every once in a while when I say this, but I actually think this is a better album. Some people might have a hard time with that because they grew up with the Live and Dangerous album and they've heard it so many times. But I do, I think the playing on this is better, I think where we were at – headspace – was a lot better. If it's not a better album then it absolutely stands right next to it, shoulder to shoulder is the only way I can explain it.”

Still Dangerous is on shelves now and the band is currently working on putting together a tour to support it. <DB>
